Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 06 (two sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 24. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
	The school has 37 classrooms, however as per land holding maximum permissible section are 28 only. Hence, the school is directed to not to use the extra rooms for

2	any academic activity. Additionally, the school is presently running 16 sections from class I to VIII, it is therefore directed to run 24 sections only for classes from I to X. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law, land holding and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
3	The school has submitted the Safe Drinking Water and Sanitary Condition Certificate issued by medical officer of hospital, which is not acceptable. Thus, the school is required to submit obtain the said certificate in format i.e. Annexure-C of SARAS Manual to be issued by an officer not below the rank of an Assistant Engineer of the Government Public Health Department(PHED) within 03 months and submit in the compliance.
4	The composite science lab does not have the washbasin with water connection in the workstations and exhaust fan. Further, there are side tables placed adjacent to the wall, which is not appropriate for conducting practical. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the same in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	The library is under stocked. Thus, the school is required to procure more books and submit the invoice along with videography of library within 03 months in the compliance.
6	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bengaluru within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be

borne by the school.

7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
